Besides overseeing the Hazardous Material Program for the Nebraska State Patrol, He is involved with providing assistance or guidance to members of several different agencies in the field of response to incidents involving Hazardous Materials (H.M.) and the shipment of H.M. and Radioactive Material (RAM).

Other duties/functions Sergeant Wagner performs are;

- Co-Coordinator of the Nebraska Hazardous Incident Team (NHIT).
- Chair of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's (CVSA) Hazardous Materials Committee.
- Member of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's North American Standard Level VI Inspection Program.
- Past Chair of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's Cooperative Hazardous Material Enforcement Development (COHMED) Program.
- Associate Staff Instructor for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) National Training Center (NTC) for General Hazardous Materials, Cargo Tank and Other Bulk Package Inspections.
- Is CVSA Level VI Qualified and is an instructor for the refresher course regarding the inspection of vehicles hauling Highway Route Controlled Quantities of Radioactive Material.
