EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 20-30

CORONA VIRUS – MOTOR VEHICLE TITLING, REGISTRATION & DRIVER LICENSES

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic made it necessary to practice social distancing for the health and safety of all Nebraskans;

WHEREAS, county offices, which had mostly been closed during March, April, and May, have re-opened allowing normal business operations of the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles to be conducted; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to process Department of Motor Vehicles' documents that were temporarily waived under Executive Order No. 20-05 and to give sufficient notice to Nebraskans to apply for, pay, or renew their driver licenses, titles, registrations, and motor vehicles sales taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Nebraska, hereby order the following:

1. All driver licenses, identification cards, commercial driver licenses, other conditional or provisional permits, handicap parking permits, vehicle titles, vehicle sales tax, in-transits, and vehicle registrations that were temporarily extended under Executive Order No. 20-05 will be required to be obtained and paid by August 31, 2020.
2. Motor carrier fuel tax late penalties and interest payments required under Article 14 of Neb. Rev. Stat. Chapter 66 that were temporarily waived under Executive Order No. 20-05 will no longer be waived effective August 31, 2020. The Motor Carrier Services Division of the Department of Motor Vehicles will resume fuel tax late penalty and interest assessments on September 1, 2020.

3. This order specifically does not rescind the waiver for driver license renewals for Nebraskan residents who are 72 years of age or older that is granted by Executive Order No. 20-25.
4. Executive Order No. 20-05, dated March 19, 2020, shall be rescinded effective at 11:59 P.M. on August 31, 2020.
